



Approved DUI Evaluation Screening Instruments

Idaho Misdemeanor Criminal Rule 9.4 requires the use of at least three (3) screening instruments approved by the Department of Health and Welfare. The GAIN SS and a criminogenic risk needs screening tool are required screening instruments for all evaluations and represent two (2) of the required three (3) screening instruments. Evaluators are responsible for the costs of obtaining, training, administration, and interpretation of screening instruments. Reports or any other printed materials produced by these instruments may be included in the evaluation. However, the materials **cannot replace or substitute the Face Sheet or Evaluation Report** in the required format. The approved instruments in no particular order are:

1. Addiction Severity Index (ASI)

Notes: Strong measure of the need for further assessment and measuring severity of alcohol dependence/abuse issues. Can be completed and scored in 15 minutes. The tool is available in both English and Spanish.
