RE: ATR III Follow-Up GPRA reminders

As we approach the second year of the Access to Recovery III Grant, we need to start collecting Follow-up Client GPRA data. As a reminder:

- Although Follow-up GPRA's allow you to submit a GPRA that contains no data, it does **not** count towards the completion rate percentage.
- If you are unable to complete a Follow-up GPRA, please contact BPA to assist in finding the client or completing the GPRA.
- Please do not submit a Follow-up GPRA in Provider Connect that is incomplete if you have not contacted BPA first for help in obtaining the missing data.
- Follow-up GPRA's should not be closed without data if there is ample time to find the client for the follow up.

BPA will be making enhancements to the Missing/Rejected GPRA report. While we are making these enhancements, we will not be posting the report. We will notify you when the changes have been made and the report is posted on Provider Connect.
