RE: Process for CPSA Clients beginning July 1, 2011

We have recently received inquiries to the process for treating Child Protection Substance Abuse (CPSA) clients effective July 1, 2011. We'd like provide the following information that might help answer some of those questions.

- The Department of Health & Welfare (DHW) will manage the clients referred by a CPSA Liaison.
- There are no EA/TANF funds available after July 1, 2011. The liaisons are no longer required to contact the navigators.
- The 90 day benefit max has expired and clients may be clinically eligible for care beyond the initial 90 days.
- CPSA clients will be clinically managed by BPA through the Continued Services Review (CSR) process. The providers are to submit CSR forms to BPA for continued care, if needed.
- If clients were receiving treatment funding outside of the DHW State Substance Use Disorder system and would like to screen for re-entry into this funding option, the liaison will submit a client intake packet to BPA. The liaison is encouraged to submit the intake packet with continued communication with the CPSA staff
- If the clients have been discharged and would like to re-enter treatment, the liaison will submit a client intake packet to BPA. The liaison is encouraged to submit the intake packet with continued communication with the CPSA staff
- The intake packet for the liaisons has not changed and includes the Client Intake Form, Release of Information, Financial Eligibility form and the GAIN-SS.
- The client is not eligible under CPSA funding if the CPS case is closed. Providers will complete the discharge paperwork and send to BPA. The client may call BPA to rescreen to see if they may be eligible under another funding source.
