Within the last few days you received a memo and a copy of the “final” rule that was sent to the Board of Health and Welfare. Unfortunately, I sent you the wrong iteration of the rule. What you received was **not** the final rule. Please disregard what was sent to you. Attached to this memo is a copy of the correct final rule. You will also be able to find this rule on the following website on November 4<sup>th</sup>:

There are two items within the final rule that we will be changing at the board meeting. These changes came from a request by the Interagency Committee on Substance Abuse Prevention and Treatment during their meeting on October 28, 2009. These items are:

1. Case Managers will have 6 months to attend case management training post employment.
2. We are removing the fee for the renewal of facility approval. We will only charge the fee for new providers and/or location.
3. We are continuing to assess the qualifications to become a QSUDP.

In addition, ICSA requested that over the summer the Department meet with providers to continue the dialogue on provider issues and any potential unintended consequences of the new rule. The Department also agreed to continue to follow the development of the NAADAC chapter in Idaho with the potential of adding the NAADAC MAC to the rule as a qualifying certification for a QSUDP during the SFY12 legislative session.
