SUBJECT: Pregnant Women and Women with Dependent Children Pilot Program

The Idaho Division of Behavioral Health is beginning the process of establishing a pilot program to implement the delivery of comprehensive care for pregnant women and women with dependent children. The comprehensive services will include trauma-informed SUD gender-specific care, relationship counseling, parenting education and recovery support services for the woman as well as, medical care, case management and transportation of the women and for their children. Services for the children include developmental screenings and services, therapeutic interventions for issues of sexual and physical abuse and neglect and child care.

All services are delivered in an outpatient setting. Agencies serving this population will not be required to directly provide all services, but must ensure women and their children have access to each service.
