We have recently completed the process of developing a PWWC Specialty Network which consists of providers in each region to offer the full range of services to pregnant and parenting women as required by the block grant. As you know, BPA invited interested providers to submit an application to join this network. We have selected the following providers to serve PWWC clients in their region:

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The PWWC Specialty Network provides the full range of services for pregnant or parenting women including PWWC case management, referral for primary medical care and prenatal care, pediatric care for children, gender specific treatment, therapeutic interventions for children and referrals for child care, if needed. Pregnant women or women with children that are ages 12 and under who meet eligibility criteria (demographic, financial and clinical) can receive treatment with PWWC funds.

Though the Specialty Network providers will be recommended to the PWWC population in these areas due to the full range of services offered, we will continue to offer choice of providers to all clients. In addition, PWWC clients located in areas of the state without a PWWC Specialty Provider will continue to have access to services through the IDHW provider network.
