The new IDAPA rules, 16.07.20 – Alcohol and Substance Use Disorders Treatment and Recovery Support Services Facilities and Programs went into effect on May 1, 2010. These rules replace your current Business Psychology Associates (BPA) contractual requirement to adhere to the rules and standards in IDAPA 16.06.03. Due to the new rules, it is necessary to amend your current contract to reflect this change.

The attached contract amendment serves to update your current contract and ensure that the new IDAPA rules are covered.
