

Timelines

Important Dates for Application/Attestation

- July 1, 2014 – Application/attestation for Stage 2, Meaningful Use (MU) for Idaho Medicaid Electronic Health Records (EHR) Incentive Program began.
- October 1, 2014 – Last day for eligible providers (EP), participating in their first year of MU, to register and attest to receive an incentive payment for the 2014 EHR program year to avoid the 2015 1% holdback from CMS.
- December 31, 2014 – Last day for eligible hospitals (EH) and critical access hospitals (CAH) to register and attest to receive an incentive payment for federal fiscal year (FFY) 2014 under the Medicaid EHR Incentive Program. This date accounts for a three month 'tail' period at the end of the FFY. EH's patient encounter data is always drawn from the previous completed FFY when applying/attesting.
- March 31, 2015 – Last day for EPs to register and attest to receive an incentive payment for Program Year 2014, calendar year (CY) 2014. This date accounts for a three month 'tail' period at the end of the CY.
- December 31, 2016 - Last date to begin participation.
