



## Idaho Hospital Association Survey Results Summary

During May and June 2011, the Idaho Hospital Association (IHA), coordinating with Idaho Medicaid and their SMHP development consultant, Public Knowledge, released a survey to its 46 members regarding health information technology (HIT) and electronic health record (EHR) adoption within Idaho hospitals. The survey was a follow-up to the more comprehensive landscape assessment survey released during the summer of 2010. The survey contained seven questions about hospital HIT and EHR adoption. This document provides a summary of the survey results based on hospitals that responded to the survey. To this end, note that any stated percentages are based on total hospital responses and *not* of the total hospital population in Idaho. The key findings are:

### Survey Statistics

**Hospitals have already implemented or plan on implementing EHRs.** 16 of hospital respondents have an EHR or are in the process of implementing one – a 5% increase from last year. The rest plan on implementing within the next 5 years.

**A majority of hospitals with EHRs are already using an ONC certified system.** 10 hospitals are using an ONC certified system (63%). Five are unsure of ONC certification status. One is not certified, but will be in 2012 or later.


**Most hospitals with EHRs plan on participating in both Medicare and Medicaid incentive programs.** 15 hospitals (71%) plan on applying for both Medicare and Medicaid incentive programs. Five (24%) are undecided. One is ineligible for both programs (state psychiatric hospital).



One hospital reported they are using an EHR that has not yet been certified by the Office of the National Coordinator (ONC). The EHR will be certified by 2012.
