




Care Services

HIV/AIDS Programs Administered By the Idaho STD/AIDS Program

The Idaho STD/AIDS Program administers a Ryan White CARE Act Title II grant and receives HIV/AIDS Prevention funds through the Centers for Disease Control. Idaho also receives Ryan White CARE Act Title III, funding a primary health care clinic located in Boise, Idaho, a satellite clinic in Pocatello, Idaho, and a physician who travels to southcentral Idaho. Northern Idaho residents have access to CHAS (Community Health Association of Spokane), which receives Title III funding located in Spokane, Washington. The STD/AIDS Program is the LPS (Local Performance Site) in Idaho for the NW AETC (Northwest AIDS Education and Training Center) and receives funding to provide HIV/AIDS education to primary care physicians, pharmacists, dentists, dental hygienists, nurses, nurse practitioners, and physician assistants throughout the state.
