COURSE DESCRIPTION

The STD Update course provides participants with training in the most recent advancements in the epidemiology, diagnosis, and management of viral and bacterial STDs.

COURSE OBJECTIVES

By the end of the course participants will be able to:

1. Discuss the latest STD diagnostic procedures for sexually transmitted infections.
2. List the current recommended treatments for prevalent sexually transmitted infections.
3. State the clinical and laboratory criteria for diagnosis of the diseases covered.

AUDIENCE

This course is designed for clinicians in Idaho who diagnose and treat patients with sexually transmitted infections.

OPTIONAL 2-DAY CLINICAL PRACTICUM

COURSE DESCRIPTION

The STD Clinical Practicum includes basic examination skills, skill development in sexual history taking, review of clinical case studies and hands-on experience in the STD clinic and laboratory under the direct supervision of a skilled preceptor.

COURSE OBJECTIVES

By the end of the course participants will be able to:

1. Elicit and record a focused medical and sexual history
2. Discern appropriate indications for laboratory studies
3. Determine appropriate therapy for the diagnosed condition

AUDIENCE

This course is designed for clinicians in Idaho who have **completed the STD Update course on August 27-28th**, have at least six months STD exam experience.

REGISTRATION

Please indicate your interest in the Clinical Practicum on your online registration for the August 27-28th STD Update course.

Clinical Practicum will take place at the Central District Health Department STD Clinic in Boise. Practicum participants must produce evidence of workers' compensation and liability insurance coverage for their participation in the clinical practicum at Central District Health and such documentation of this insurance must be submitted to Central District Health in advance of practicum. There is a \$100 per participant fee for the practicum, payable to Central District Health in advance. Fees for practicum students from Idaho Health Public Health Districts will be waived. **After receiving confirmation of their acceptance**, qualified participants (those who have successfully completed the August 27-28th STD Update course and have at least six months STD exam experience) will schedule practicum sessions directly through the Central District Health Department STD Clinic. **Practicum participation is limited to 6 students so early registration is imperative.**
