Per IDAPA 16.03.19.200.11.h, the provider must inform, in writing, each resident of his or her right to formulate advance directives; this written information is found in the Certified Family Home Provider Manual under "Advance Directives Information," or on the website for the Office of the Attorney General at www.ag.idaho.gov (search "Living Wills").
