





Gooding County adjoins the Snake River plain in south-central Idaho. It ranks 21st among Idaho counties in population and 36th in area. The federal government owns over 50 percent of the county. Agriculture and food processing are the primary industries, with additional employment provided by government, trade, and services. Annual average total civilian employment increased 30.9 percent from 1996 to 2006. Major employers include Glanbia Inc., Gooding County government, Gooding School District, Gooding County Hospital, Kiefer Built LLC, The Walker Center, and Idaho State School for the Deaf and Blind.

Malad Gorge State Park near Tuttle, Thousand Springs Reserve between Hagerman and Wendell, and the Hagerman Fossil Beds National Monument are area attractions. It is home to Fossil Gulch Wind Park Idaho's first industrial-scale wind power generation project. Also of interest are the state and federal fish hatcheries near the town of Hagerman.




Level and Type of EMS Courses 2005-2007










Collision History 2004-2006

Highway Miles (Gravel is considered improved)







EMS Agency Licensure Levels




EMS Agency Structure




EMS Agency Classification




EMS Agency Structure Transport/NonTransport



EMS Agency Staff Mix 2007-2008




EMS Specialized Team Capabilities

Historic EMS Manpower Complement 2000-2008







### Dedicated Fund Vehicle Grants
