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The EMS Bureau, in partnership with the State Office of Rural Health, is making limited funds available to offset increased costs of National Registry testing fees and State Criminal History Check (CHC – Background Check) fees. Agencies affiliating volunteer personnel at the First Responder, EMT-Basic, and Advanced EMT-A levels are eligible to apply. Reimbursements will be made from January 2 through June 1, 2007, or until the limited funds are depleted.

To receive reimbursement, the affiliating agency must complete and submit the following three documents dated between January 2 and June 1, 2007 for each candidate:

- A "Scholarship Award Program Application"
- A copy of the National Registry "Authorization To Test" letter
- A copy of the CHC provided receipt

If the test candidate has paid the fee(s) directly, the requesting agency should reimburse the individual for the amount received from the EMS Bureau. An application form is included and additional forms are available at EMS Bureau offices or our web site www.idahoems.org. A confirmation letter will be sent to the agency and the candidate upon the Bureau's acceptance. A check will be sent to the EMS agency approximately two weeks after receipt in the EMS Bureau office.
