Enfagrow NeuroPro™ Toddler Nutrition Drink – Vanilla has replaced Enfagrow Next Step Vanilla

Enfamil AR RTF is discontinued, Enfamil Premium Newborn has been discontinued and removed from the formulary.

Pregestimil is no longer available in a food package but is now available through a direct bill with Coram.

Pediasure Grow and Gain and with fiber, Pediasure Peptid, Pediasure 1.5 CAL and with fiber, Pediasure 1.0 enteral formula 1.0 and with fiber, and Pediasure Sidekicks changes in formulation with the addition of DHA and Lutein and changes in protein arrangement.

Nutricia Neocate Infant DHA/ARA, Nutricia Neocate Junior and Nutricia Junior with fiber, Nutricia Neocate Nutra, Nutricia Neocate Splash unflavored and flavored, and Nutricia Neocate Syneo Infant changes in the formulation to cow milk allergies, multiple food allergies and soy oil free. All other Nutricia products were updated with formulation changes. The reconstituted amounts added for any all products that did not have them.

The following products have been discontinued from Nutricia Add-Ins, flavor packets, Methionaid, Peptide Junior, and XLYS- XTRP Maxamum, and removed from the formulary.

Nestle Healthcare Nutrition changed name to Nestle Health Science. All Nestle products updated.

Formulations of all Nestle products including Gerber and Mead Johnson updated too.

Nestle has discontinued the following products, FAA- Free Amino Acids, Gerber Good Start (GS) Protect and 2 Protect, Gerber GS 2 Soy, Gerber GS premature 20, 24, and 24 High Pro, Gerber GS Grow, Gerber Graduates Protect, Impact with fiber and Impact Gutamine, Peptamen OS and OS 1.5, Resource Thicken-up Thickened Dairy, Juice, Water, and Shake Drinks, Resource Nutritious Juice Drink, Resource Custard, Fruit Sorbet, Health Shake, Health Shake No Sugar Added, and Shake Plus, these have been removed from the formulary.

Nutriment was sold to another company and they turned it into an energy drink, removed from formulary.

A-SOY, Bright Beginnings products -Perrigo (formerly PBM Products, LLC) have been discontinued and removed from the formulary.

Bright Beginnings Soy Pediatric drink formulation updated.

Ensure Enlive removed from formulary due to product formulation changes. Added Ensure Clear to formulary because of the removal of Ensure Enlive. (both were clear liquid products, now only Ensure Clear is clear liquid.)

Formulations of all Abbott products including Similac products updated. Reconstituted amounts were added for multiple products.

Similac Go & Grow- Soy stage 3 was discontinued in 2015 and removed from formulary

Formulation changes to Nature's One products added such as calories or reconstituted amounts

Products discontinued from Nutricia and Applied Nutrition Corp, Complex MSD Amino Acid Bars, Phenylade Amino Acid Bars, Phenylade MTE Amino Acid Blends, Phenylade RTD Flavor Blast Original, these have been removed from the formulary.

Hepatic Aid II Instant Drink was discontinued and removed from the formulary. OneSource products (OneSource, 2% OneSource Optimal Nutrition Drink) removed from formulary, not medical foods.

Aptalis products removed, company was bought out and all products were bought by other companies and or are not medical foods. Scandical Calorie Booster, Scandishake, scandishake lactose free.

March 2019

Effective January 29, 2019 Abbott Similac Soy Isomil has replaced Gerber Good Start Soy as the standard soy formula.

Effective March 1, 2019 Similac Sensitive, Similac Spit Up, and Similac Total Comfort have been added to Idaho WIC's Exempt formulas.

Abbott Similac® Soy Isomil® Concentrated Liquid is undergoing a minor ingredient sourcing change that changes the order of ingredients on the label. There are no changes to the graphics of the label, price, UPC, name, or reconstituted ounces per unit. (not Idaho WIC approved)

- Abbott PediaSure® (Grow & Gain) products will continue to undergo a packaging update into a slightly taller bottle July-September 2017. There are no changes to the UPC, graphics, name, price, formulation or reconstituted ounces per unit. (Idaho WIC approved)
- Effective May 2017 Mead Johnson will be shipping a new style of Nutramigen 32 fl. oz. ready-to-use bottle (Idaho WIC approved)

October 2016

- Product 3232A (Mead Johnson) reformulated to add selenium and other minor ingredient changes June/July 2016.
- Gerber Graduates Soy Infant & Toddler Formula Discontinuation effective April 2016.
- Gerber introduces Stage 3 Gerber Good Start Soy Infant & Toddler Formula (2016).
- Gerber transitions all of their standard infant formulas to non-GMO (contract soy formula Idaho WIC approved)
- Gerber introduces Gerber Good Start Soy Infant Formulas have undergone a label appearance change. (no change to the 12.9 oz. can size and 91 fl. Oz. recon rate.)
- Keotcal (Nutricia product) 4:1 product changes, the can yield = 70.5 oz. (2115 kcals at 30kcal/oz. per 300g can). Change beginning May 2016. (Idaho WIC approved)
- Monogen (Nutricia product) has been reformulated to include increased essential fatty acids, updated macronutrient profile, increased medium chain triglycerides (MCT), added DHA & ARA. (Idaho WIC approved)

February 2016

- Enfacare RTU will no longer be available in the 32-oz. container, they will offer 8 oz. bottles in a 6-pack or 2 oz. bottles in an 8-pack.
- Similac Alimentum Powder will change to a 12.1 oz. can and the reconstituted amount will be 87 fl oz.
- Label change for Similac NeoSure (all NeoSure products), Similac for Diarrhea (Only RTF available) and Similac Alimentum (RTF). Only the label will change. "Expert Care" will be removed from the label.
- Mead Johnson introduces Puramino Toddler, new WIC-Eligible Nutritional product.
- Enfamil Premature Low-Iron Infant RTF formula in 24 Cal and 20 Cal (2 oz. RTU 6 packs) were discontinued in December 2015 (only the low-iron versions).
- Abbott introduces NON-GMO Similac product options (Similac Sensitive, Advance, Go & Grow). These are not WIC approved options.
- Minor updates/clarifications to the Similac line of products.
- Enfagrow Next Step RTF products package sizes changed.
- Nutricia North America to discontinue products and introduced new metabolic products (See October 2015 changes below). Reconstituted amounts updated for a variety of these metabolic products.
