

WICSmart Scenario Discussion

Scenario 1

Answer: NO

Discussion Points: Provide mom with weaning information during the appointment. This family might be eligible for WICSmart in the future.

Nutrition Risk Criterion (NRC) 103: Registered Dietitian (RD) in 1-3 months. This was done, but the risk code applies after the health screen as well. Unless the RD documented that it is not necessary to bring him back for a RD appointment, schedule with the RD in 1-3 months (3 months if growth is consistent.)

201: Hgb Recheck within 6 mo. This can be done at certification.

Scenario 2

Answer: NO

Discussion Points: Pepper is high risk based on NRC 131, 132, 344. Next appointment should be with the RD. After that appointment the RD can determine if WICSmart is appropriate. If WICSmart is deemed appropriate, this should be documented by the RD.

Scenario 3

Answer: DEPENDS

Discussion Points: Based on NRC WICSmart is an option for this family. If reading the English language is a concern WICSmart may not be a good fit. WICSmart has English and Spanish modules. If data and internet access are a concern, WICSmart may not be a good fit. What are some probing questions you can ask?

Scenario 4

Answer: YES

Discussion Points: NRCs are low risk, family has access to an appropriate device and internet. WICSmart will be a great convenience for this family.
