SHERRY HAS WORKED TO EDUCATE ALL STAFF ON THE IMPORTANCE OF IMMUNIZATIONS AND SCREENING AT EVERY VISIT, CORRECT DOCUMENTATION, AND BEST PRACTICES FOR DISCUSSING IMMUNIZATIONS WITH PARENTS. THIS HAS INCLUDED MEETING ONE-ON-ONE WITH EACH NURSING STAFF MEMBER TO REVIEW REQUIREMENTS AND ADDRESS QUESTIONS.

IN ADDITION TO THE TRAINING, SHERRY CREATED A POLICY OUTLINING DOCUMENTATION REQUIREMENTS AND HOW THEY WILL BE MET. TO MAKE IMMUNIZATION DOCUMENTATION AS COMPLETE AND CORRECT AS POSSIBLE, SHE UPDATED ALL PAPER IMMUNIZATION RECORDS TO THE UP-TO-DATE CLINIC HISTORY FORM (THE YELLOW CARD).

SHERRY STRIVES TO CREATE A CULTURE OF IMMUNIZATION WITHIN THE CLINIC AND PROVIDE THE BEST SERVICES TO THE COMMUNITY AS POSSIBLE.
