# Two Opt-Out Options

## Patient medical information only

1

- Removal of vaccination dates and provider information
- Leaves minimal patient demographic information
  - Enough information to “block” any incoming records

## All patient information

2

- Removal of both medical and demographic information
  - No information is left to “block” incoming records, so patient may need to opt-out multiple times

# Medical Providers...

- Inform all patients that their vaccination information will be entered into IRIS, and that IRIS is a voluntary system
- Patients may opt-out of IRIS at anytime through the IIP

# Medical Providers

- Keep patient information out of IRIS when the patient has an IRIS opt-out confirmation letter
- Account for all doses of vaccine administered to patients who have opted-out





# Patient Responsibilities

- Compete the IRIS opt-out form
  - [www.immunizeidaho.com](http://www.immunizeidaho.com)
- Receive an opt-out confirmation letter
  - Sent once the process has been completed
- Provide a copy of the opt-out letter to medical provider
