4. Varicella: History of chickenpox disease documented by a physician or licensed health care professional meets the requirement.
5. 7th Grade Requirements: These requirements apply to all 7th-12th grade students






Exemption Rate for All Antigens by Grade



Adequate Record Rate for All Antigens by Grade



12th Grade Meningococcal Booster

05. Twelfth Grade Immunization Requirements. Effective at the start of the 2020-2021 school year, and each year thereafter, in addition to the required immunizations listed in Section 100.01 through 100.04 of this rule, students must meet the following minimum immunization requirements prior to admission into the 12th grade:

- a. Students who received their first dose of Meningococcal (MenACWY) before the age of sixteen (16) must have two (2) doses of Meningococcal (MenACWY).
- b. Students who received their first dose of Meningococcal (MenACWY) at sixteen (16) years of age and older must have one (1) dose of Meningococcal (MenACWY).
- c. Twelfth grade immunization requirements.


