is Director of the National Center for Immunization

and Respiratory Diseases (NCIRD). Since beginning her public health career in 1995 as an Epidemic Intelligence Service Officer in 1995 in the National Center for Infectious Diseases (NCID), Dr. Messonnier has held a number of leadership posts across CDC and within NCIRD. She served as Deputy Director for NCIRD from October 2014 through March 2016 and led the Meningitis and Vaccine Preventable Diseases Branch in NCIRD's Division of Bacterial Diseases since its formation in 2007 through 2012. Dr. Messonnier received her BA from the University of Pennsylvania and MD from the University of Chicago School of Medicine.



**JENNIFER REICH,  
PH.D.**

is Professor of Sociology at the University of Colorado Denver. Her

research examines how individuals and families strategize their interactions with the state and service providers in the context of public policy, particularly as they relate to health and welfare. She is author of two award-winning books, *Fixing Families: Parents, Power, and the Child Welfare System* (2005) and *Calling the Shots: Why Parents Reject Vaccines* (2016), co-editor of the book, *Reproduction and Society* (2014), and has written more than 30 articles and book chapters that explore child welfare, childhood vaccinations, reproduction, multiracial families, public assistance, and recovery after disaster.
