Children/Youth with Special Health Care Needs

Idaho MCH leadership developed a state action plan with specific objectives and strategies to address priorities within each MCH domain area during the needs assessment process. The following presents the priority needs and objectives for the Children/Youth with Special Health Care Needs domain area.

NPM = National Performance Measure

SPM = State Performance Measure

Priority Need: Improve maternal and child health population access to medical homes.

NPM 11: Medical Home - Percent of children with and without special health care needs having a medical home.

Objective: By September 2020, fund and support services, programs, and activities focused on improving quality of care for CYSHCN.

Priority Need: Improve access to medical specialists for CYSHCN.

SPM 2: Specialist Access - Percent of children with special health care needs who needed or received specialist care in the past 12 months, and experienced some problem accessing care.

Objective: By September 2020, fund and support services, programs, and activities focused on screening, referral, and access to medical specialists.
