**What is the Medical Reserve Corps?** The MRC is a nationwide program created to engage and train volunteers to strengthen public health preparedness, emergency response, and community resilience. Volunteers will be pre-credentialed, trained and ready to respond when needed. No medical training is necessary and all service is voluntary.

- Disaster education and crisis counseling
- Link victims to community resources
- Behavioral health outreach for disaster survivors
- Support services for disaster response staff

- Mental health counselors
- Social workers
- School counselors
- Behavioral health case managers
- Substance use disorder professionals
- Chaplains
- Psychiatric nurses
- Anyone with experience in a closely related field



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
