



- Total for Idaho residents includes one abortion with age of patient not stated.
- Ratio: Number of induced abortions per 1,000 live births to Idaho residents. Rate: Number of induced abortions per 1,000 women 15-44 years of age.
- Other includes marriages or divorces where one is a resident and one is a non-resident or where one or both with state of residence is not stated.
