East Boise County Ambulance District (EBCAD), Director of Operations

The principal function of the EBCAD Director of Operations is to manage/implement the daily and long-term direction of the District including emergency response, volunteer recruitment/retention, and overall administration of the District. The job requires strong leadership and organizational skills to manage a large number of staff, both paid and volunteer, and reports directly to the Boise County Board of County Commissioners who serve as the Governing Board of the District.

Position requirements include knowledge of: State and Federal regulations covering EMS ambulance services; County, region, State and Federal communication requirements and procedures; training techniques; public relations and interpersonal skills; fiscal financial management; record keeping requirements and protocol for compliance with County, State and Federal requirements.

Applicants must, at a minimum, hold a current Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) license and a valid driver's license. Salary is dependent upon experience, position has full benefit package including health insurance and participation in PERSI, the Public Employee Retirement System.

Interested candidates must submit both an application and a resume. Candidates shall use a Boise County application which can be obtained from the Boise County website www.boisecounty.us (under the Employment tab) or picked up from the Clerk's Office at 420 Main Street, Idaho City, ID 83631.
