

**Idaho Medicaid Preferred Drug List Recommendations
May 20, 2011**

Idaho Medicaid makes the following recommendations for the Idaho Medicaid Preferred Drug List. These recommendations are based on the clinical recommendations of the Pharmacy and Therapeutics Committee from the April 15, 2011 and May 20, 2011 meetings and take into consideration public and prescriber input, utilization patterns and cost data.
