SUBJECT: NEW PAYMENT RATES EFFECTIVE July 1, 2018

Effective July 1, 2018, the Department is making changes to reimbursement rates for service codes billed by Residential Habilitation Agency Providers as outlined below. In accordance with IDAPA 16.03.10.037, the Department calculated new rates based on the 2016 cost survey that was completed using 2015 cost data.

Services provided on or before June 30, 2018, must be billed separately from services provided on or after July 1, 2018. There may be an error in your payment if you do not use separate claim forms.

The new rates are listed below by procedure code:

Procedure Code	Modifier	Description	Amount
H2015		Individual Supported Living (1 unit = 15 minutes)	\$ 5.31
H2015	HQ	Group Supported Living (1 unit = 15 minutes)	\$ 2.71
H2016		Daily Supported Living – Intense (1 unit = daily rate)	\$ 509.76
H2016		Daily Supported Living – Intense/School Days (1 unit = daily rate)	\$ 403.56
H2016		Daily Supported Living – High/School Days (1 unit = daily rate)	\$ 219.33
H2022		Daily Supported Living – High (1 unit = daily rate)	\$ 277.04

Providers do not need to submit plan changes, addendums, or Prior Authorization (PA) requests related to these rate changes. Existing Prior Authorizations will be updated automatically as a result of this change.

For dates of service on or after July 1, 2018, claims submitted by Residential Habilitation Agency providers for the above procedure codes will be reimbursed at the fee schedule rate or the rate that is billed, whichever is lower.

For participants accessing hourly supported living under the Adult Developmental Disability waiver, Bureau of Developmental Disability Services care managers will continue to review plans to assure they are within the adjusted daily cap, meet criteria for assessed needs, and provide for health and safety.

- Effective July 1, 2018, the adjusted daily cap is \$268.09 per day for hourly supported living in combination with developmental therapy, community supported employment, and adult day health.
- Plans submitted after July 15, 2018, must be costed with the new rate and will not be modified by the Department.
